これから、リスニングテストを行います。問題用紙の1ページ目を見なさい。リスニングテストは、全て放送による指示で行います。リスニングテストの問題には、問1と問2の2つがあります。質問に対する答えを選んで、その記号を答えなさい。問題用紙の余白にメモをとってもかまいません。答えは全て解答用紙に書きなさい。

【問1】

問1は、英語による対話を聞いて、英語の質問に答えるものです。ここで話される対話は3つあり、それぞれ質問が1つずつ出題されます。質問に対する答えを選んで、その記号を答えなさい。英文と質問は1度だけ放送されます。

それでは<対話文1>を始めます。

Man : Kate, do you think we can do the club activity at the school yard today?

Woman : Well, I don't think so. It'll be rainy, so it seems to be canceled.

Man : The tournament will be held next month, so I think we should practice more.

Woman : Yeah, let's talk about it with Mr. Smith.

Man : If we are not allowed to practice outside, how about having a meeting, instead?

Woman : Question. What will they do this afternoon?

Man : Hi, Yoko. I haven't seen you for weeks. How have you been?

Woman : Well, I've decided to go to America to study. I've been busy preparing for it.

Man : Really? Will you change your school?

Woman : Well, I'll come back to this school after staying in America for six months. I'm leaving Japan next month.

Man : Question. What is Yoko going to do?

Man : May I help you?

Woman : Yes, I'd like to buy some souvenirs. Could you recommend something typical?

Man : Sure. We have some maple syrup and maple cookies.

Woman : That sounds nice! But I can buy them at a supermarket in Japan. Anything else?

Man : Do you know about Dreamcatchers? They're charms.

Woman : That sounds nice. I'll take it. How much is it?

Man : It's five dollars.

Woman : OK. I'd like two. Can you give a discount?

Man : All right. Well..., how about seven dollars?

Woman : Question. How much cheaper will it be in total?

【問 2】

問 2 は、Takeshi が東京オリンピック 2020 をテレビで観戦したことをもとにして行った英語のスピーチを聞いて、英語の質問に答えるものです。質問は 3 つ出題されます。質問に対する答えを選んで、その記号を答えなさい。英文と質問は全体を通して 2 度放送されます。それでは始めます。

Takeshi:

The 2020 Summer Olympics in Tokyo started on July 23rd. I had a ticket to watch the judo match during this event. But unfortunately I was not able to go to see it because of the influence of the coronavirus. So I watched it on TV with my family. I have practiced judo for five years. I started it when I was eight. When we were watching TV, my grandfather suddenly told me that he tried to become an Olympic athlete sixty years ago. He practiced judo very hard to make his dream come true for the Olympics in 1964. Though he made great efforts, he got hurt and stopped doing judo. I was very surprised to hear his story and felt sad. He hoped that many Japanese judo athletes would win many gold medals this time. As a result, they got nine gold medals. It was amazing. I was deeply impressed with it and I said to myself, "I will never give up."
