# Toyo University Graduate Schools Entrance Examinations for the Internal Recommendation Category for April Admission 2024 (February Examination)

(Doctoral Program: Graduate School of Global and Regional Studies/Graduate School of International Tourism Management)

Toyo University Graduate Schools will hold the Entrance Examinations for the Internal Recommendation Category for April Admission 2024 in accordance with the following schedule.

Those who wish to sit for the entrance examinations are required to contact the Education Affairs Section for Graduate Schools (mldaig-ad@toyo.jp) by the prescribed period for confirmation of grades, etc. We will notify you of the required documents for confirmation of grades, etc.

\*Be sure to submit an up-to-date academic transcript as below:

- Current students: Those who are in the semester system, an academic transcript issued on October 1, 2023 or later / Those who are in the full-year system, an academic transcript issued on April 1, 2023 or later
- Those who have completed the Master's Program: an academic transcript issued on March 25 or later of their completion year (on September 25 or later for applicants who have completed the Master's Program in September)
