

Pre-Arrival Entrance Exam
Frequently Asked Questions for Applicants

● Application Period/Exam Date

Can I choose an examination date? Can I choose the other dates outside of the indicated dates?

--- No. Examination (online interview) will be scheduled on one of the designated examination dates. The exam dates cannot be scheduled outside of the scheduled dates.

Could you check if my application is complete? Can I get my applications preliminary reviewed?

--- No. It is your responsibility to make sure whether you have submitted all the required documents.

● Eligibility

I am in the second semester of college. Can I apply?

--- Yes as long as you will either complete or leave your current program before you enter Toyo University.

I have completed the undergraduate study. Can I apply?

---Yes.

For Type A applicants:

--- Toyo Top Global Scholarship A is a 4-year full degree undergraduate program. If you have completed your undergraduate degree already, your application can be considered for the scholarship as long as you are willing to start the program from a freshman year and spend another 4 years to complete the program.

*Please be warned in case you were to leave the program without completing the degree in 4 years, you may be asked to return a full or a part of the scholarship you would have received by that time.

I have completed the undergraduate study at another university. Am I eligible for Top Toyo Global Scholarship A? Can I transfer any credits?

<Eligibility>

--- Yes, you are eligible as long as you are willing to start the program from a freshman year and spend another 4 years to complete the program.

< Transferring credits >

--- You can be considered for international transfer to the 2nd year in one of the English track programs for the 2nd bachelor's degree. See [Application Guide](#) for more details about international transfer including the application process and transferring of academic credits from previous institution. Please be aware that Toyo Top Global Scholarship A is available only for students who start from the freshman year.

● Transcript

I am in the second semester of college. Do I need to get a transcript from high school? Can I apply just with my grades from my current university?

--- You must submit a transcript from High School. You are also advised to additionally submit a transcript from any schools you attended after high school.

● Application Fee

Do I need to pay the application fee?

--- All applicants must JPY 10,000 application fee. It can be paid ONLY by credit card.

● Reason for Application form

Should it be written or typed?

--- Applicant for Faculty of Information Networking for Innovation and Design (INIAD) must type the Reason for Application essay. For applicant for other faculty, it can be typed or hand-written. If you are going to hand-write, please be sure to write legibly.

If typed, is there any specific font type or size required?

--- There is no specific requirement for font type/size.

Should I complete 5 pages?

--- As long as you address the topics given, you are not required to fill 5 pages.

● Proof of Japanese Language Proficiency

I do not possess any qualifications to demonstrate my Japanese ability. Would this affect my eligibility to apply for this course?

--- All the Type A applicants and the applicants for Department of Global Innovation

Studies, Faculty of Global and Regional Studies, do not need to know Japanese at the time of the entrance, thus there is no need to submit a proof of Japanese language proficiency level and it would not affect your eligibility. If you'd like, you could submit a letter from your Japanese instructor which verifies your Japanese proficiency level, but that's optional.

* All the Type B applicants and the transferring applicants except for Department of Global Innovation Studies, Faculty of Global and Regional Studies, must submit either the score report of the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) or the passing certificate of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT).

● Recommendation Letter

The letter of recommendation had to come from the dean of the university last year. However on this year's guidelines it says anyone in a position of authority may prepare the letter of recommendation. Would a recommendation letter from my academic advisor be sufficient?

--- As long as the person can comment on your academic ability and personality as a student and the letter comes on a school's letterhead, the recommender does not have to be the Dean.
