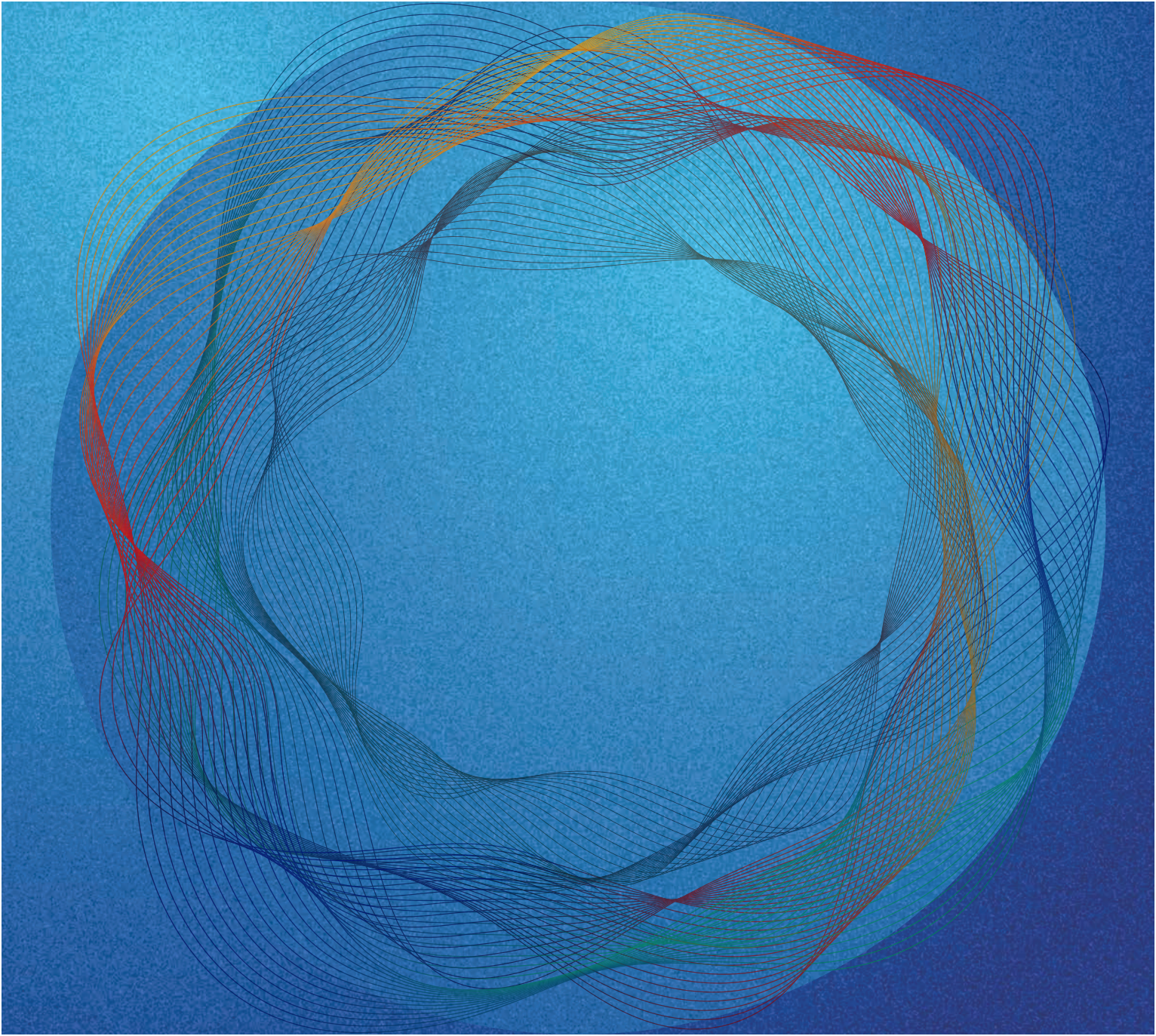

# Faculties and Departments Guide For International Students 2024





# Inheriting the "Spirit of Philosophy"

Toyo University's history started with the Philosophy Academy founded by Enryo Inoue in 1887. What has been passed down over the 130 years since then is a spirit of having one's own philosophy, thinking deeply to get to the essence of things, and striving to overcome any difficulty.



## What is Toyo University?

Toyo University continues to value the "spirit of philosophy" it inherited from its founder, Enryo Inoue. Philosophy is the foundation of all things, and is an essential part of all disciplines, including politics, law, science, and the arts. Through its programs, Toyo University cultivates the ability to think, make judgments, and act on one's own initiative. It thereby nurtures "global human resources" capable of solving society's problems while working side by side with people from around the world.



## An extensive curriculum

Toyo University allows students to study a broad range of fields, ranging from the humanities to science. Its multifaceted curriculum harnesses the advantages that come with being a comprehensive university, and its diverse staff of first-rate instructors provides highly unique lessons. Beginning in 2023, the University has fourteen faculties. Those faculties and their departments provide a comfortable learning environment for all students, regardless of gender, nationality, race, or religion.



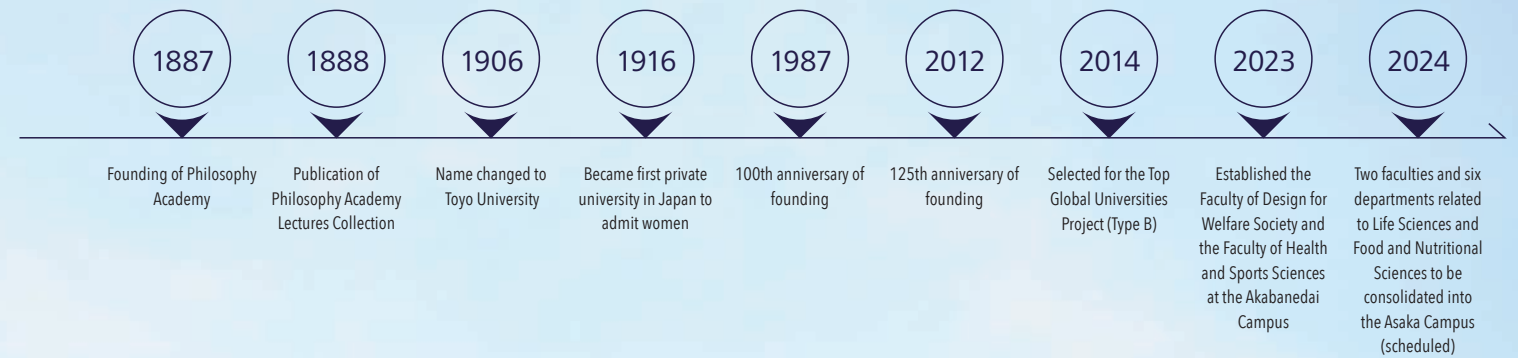
## Three foundations of education

With a program supported by the pillars of "philosophy," "globalization," and "career preparation," Toyo University cultivates human resources capable of perceiving things from a global perspective, carving out their own way forward, and taking charge of the future without being carried away by the changing times and environment. As an institution open to the world, the University attracts a wide variety of students from Japan and abroad. It also participates in a comprehensive array of overseas agreements and exchanges that forms a network extending around the globe.



## Support for academic fees, daily living, and employment

Toyo University maintains a support system to ensure that international students can study and live in Japan with peace of mind. For example, the University offers a system that reduces or exempts the equivalent of 30% of annual tuition fees as well as various unique scholarships for international students who pay their own expenses. As for daily living, Toyo University has two international residences where Japanese and international students live together and interact with one another. In addition, the University also provides a full range of programs for business Japanese language education and other skills necessary for employment in Japan.



### Toyo University's founder Enryo Inoue

Enryo Inoue was born in 1858 as the eldest son of a temple priest in Niigata Prefecture. He first encountered philosophy when he entered the newly founded University of Tokyo. When still just 29 years old, he founded the Philosophy Academy, Toyo University's predecessor, on the belief that "all knowledge is grounded in philosophy." Sensing the need to educate the masses, Enryo worked to free them from groundless superstitions by using yokai (apparitions) that were familiar to people of the time. He spoke continuously across the country about the importance of thinking and making judgments for oneself, and opened the door to education for people with no surplus money and time. Enryo traveled around the world three times and devoted his entire life to spreading philosophy and education. In 1919, while giving a lecture in Dalian, China, he collapsed and died at the age of 61.





# Expanding the boundaries of education

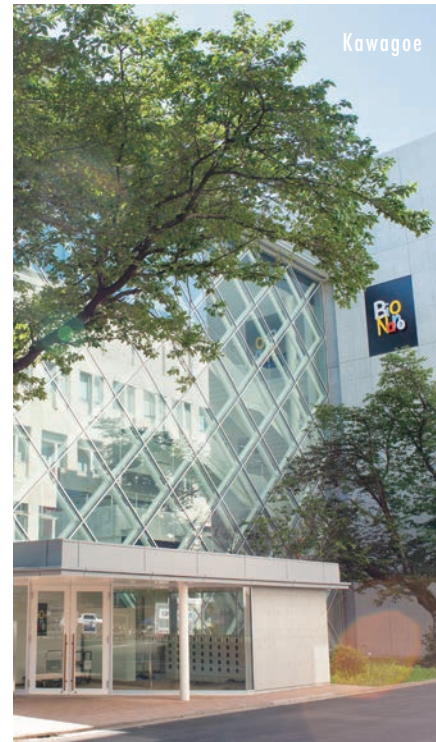
Toyo University has opened two new faculties—the Faculty of Design for Welfare Society and the Faculty of Health and Sports Sciences in the Akabanedai Campus (Kita-ku, Tokyo) in the 2023 academic year. These two faculties and their five departments will endeavor to overcome challenges in the fields of welfare, design, health, and sports science.

Furthermore, the Faculty of Life Sciences and the Faculty of Food and Nutritional Sciences will be relocated to the Asaka Campus (Asaka City, Saitama) in the following 2024 academic year. Each will establish new departments and strive to build collaboration.

Toyo University thus continues to evolve into an environment suitable for the deepening of cutting-edge research and a comfortable place for spending time.

- Money cannot be wired using financial institutions located outside of Japan.
- The Admission fee is charged in the first year only.
- In the case of newly enrolled students, if the student pays the full tuition and then receives the tuition reduction after admission, he or she will receive a refund for the amount of the reduction.
- In the case of students in their second or subsequent year who met academic standards and are recognized as eligible for the tuition reduction, students will be requested to pay a reduced tuition amount that corresponds to the academic standards for that student.
- Students are permitted to choose between paying the entire amount at one time or paying the tuition, facility fee, lab fee, and equipment fee in two installments per year.
- Students enrolling in the Faculty of Letters' Department of History or Faculty of Business Administration are required to pay a separate academic society fee. (Faculty of Letters' Department of History: 6,000 yen; Faculty of Business Administration: 4,000 yen).
- Students enrolling in the Faculty of Sociology's Department of Global Diversity Studies will participate in a one-week "global diversity exercise" either in Japan or abroad during their first year. They must therefore make a separate payment to cover associated expenses (e.g., for transport, accommodations, educational materials, meals, etc.) amounting to approximately 80,000 yen for an exercise in Japan and approximately 250,000 yen for an exercise abroad (or approximately 350,000 yen for students desiring a long-term program).
- Some courses may charge an additional payment of activity fees.
- The paid admission fee is the money as "compensation for obtaining a position that will allow the applicant to enroll in the faculty, department, and course of Toyo University to which he/she gains admission." In addition, submitted documents will not be returned.
- Tuition and fees may change for students who exceed the designated length of the course of study.

Toyo University provides various support schemes and international residences to ensure that international students can study and live in Japan with peace of mind.

### AI-House HUB- 4

AI-House HUB- 4 opened on the Akabanedai Campus in March 2022. With a multipurpose studio, a common kitchen, and many other shared spaces, it is designed for interaction among residents. Exchange events and seminars for residents are held regularly.

### International House

\*Priority for residence is given to undergraduate students in their second year or higher.

International House is conveniently located, just a 15-minute walk from the Hakusan Campus. Room types include private units and units for up to three people. They are ideal for those who want to concentrate on their studies in a quiet environment and those who want to make the most of their time. Assistance provided

- (1) Tuition assistance (Payments covering admission fee, facility fee, and lab fee, and up to 100% reduction/exemption of tuition through the combination use of tuition reductions based on support schemes for international students), and waving of other various expenses

(2) Residential support (guaranteed space in AI-House or International House)

(3) Assistance with daily living and activities

(4) Assistance with efforts to strengthen Japanese language skills
- \*Recipients are not required to return tuitions and other assistance payments that they received from the program after graduation. (Upon advancing to their second and later years of study, students will be screened for program continuation based on their academic performance and results of their SDGs activities.)

<b>Application method</b>	Applications require Internet registration. Complete the procedure by accessing TOYOWebStyle (admission website). The registration period starts three days before the first day of the application period. (The registration period for the Online Entrance Examinations starts on the first day of the application period.)
<b>Application fee</b>	The application fee is 10, 000 yen. After completing the application registration online, pay the fee at a convenience store, or a financial institution where Pay-easy is available, using internet banking, or a credit card during the application period. (The application fee for an Online Entrance Examination must be paid by credit card.)
<b>Application eligibility</b>	Eligibility varies depending on the desired faculty/department (course) and entrance exam method. Refer to the Application Guide for Admissions Offered to International students for details on application eligibility and other matters concerning Hennyugaku and Tennyugaku exams.
