**Entrance procedures for foreign students (Master Course),
who passed the primary screening of the Monbukagakusho (MEXT) Scholarship**

1. Admission policy

The Graduate School of Interdisciplinary New Science, Toyo University, accepts motivated master course students from all over the world, and educates and creates advanced researchers from an international point of view in the fields of bioscience, nanotechnology and bio-nano fusion science/technology, the latter being one of the most important subjects in the 21st Century.

**2. Documents necessary for the entrance to the Bio-Nano Science Fusion Master Course,
Graduate School of Interdisciplinary New Science, Toyo University**

The following documents should be sent by e-mail.

- (1) The same documents as submitted for the application of the 2020 MEXT Scholarship
 1. Application forms for the MEXT Scholarship
 2. Research plan specifying research field
 3. Photograph
 4. Academic transcript of each year issued by the university
 5. Graduation certificate or degree certificate
 6. Recommendation from the President or Vice-Chancellor of the university, or the supervisor of the applicant
 7. Recommendation from the employer (if currently employed)
 8. Abstract of thesis
- (2) Pass notification of the primary screening issued by the Embassy of Japan or Consulate General
- (3) Application form for Toyo University

- (4) Curriculum Vitae
 - Photograph, Present address, Telephone number, Fax number, E-mail address
 - Educational background (after high school or senior school)
 - Academic and research background, Research plan

3. Criterion for acceptance and notification

There are two procedures for the students, who will enter the Graduate School of Interdisciplinary New Science, Toyo University, in April 2020 or September 2020 as MEXT scholars, to complete.

Procedure 1

- (1) The applicant's ability to carry out internationally advanced research at the master course is judged by the academic staff of the Graduate School of Interdisciplinary New Science based on the above documents.
- (2) Toyo University will send an official letter of acceptance to a successful applicant. The Graduate School will not respond to any enquiries concerning the result. It takes approximately 14 days to post the letter after we receive the application documents. This official letter of acceptance is necessary for the second MEXT screening.

Procedure 2

- (2) The Graduate School of Interdisciplinary New Science, Toyo University, will decide the admission of each applicant, who has passed the second MEXT screening and has been recommended by MEXT to enter the Graduate School of Interdisciplinary New Science, Toyo University, in the middle of November 2019.
- (4) Toyo University will send an Admission Certificate to the successful applicants at the end of December. The Graduate School will not respond to any enquiries concerning the result.
- (5) Each applicant will be informed of the final result by the Embassy of Japan.

4. Entrance examination fee

Normally, the entrance examination fee, 35,000 yen or 310 US dollars, must be paid to Toyo University by students who will enter the Graduate School of Interdisciplinary New Science, Toyo University. However, the fee will be paid by the Japanese Government for those students, who will enter the Graduate School of Interdisciplinary New Science, Toyo University, having passed the MEXT final screening.

If a successful student is unable to enter the Graduate School of Interdisciplinary New Science, Toyo University, for some reason, the student must pay the entrance examination fee within 7 days after the date of your withdrawal from entrance to the Graduate School.

The examination fee, 35,000 yen or 310 US dollars, must be transferred directly to the following bank account via telegraphic transfer:
