

# Timetable for English Programmes

Our course timetables are explained in this document.

Our core fulltime courses (Adult Learning Programme) are scheduled from Monday to Friday. Courses may be scheduled in the morning (am) or in the afternoon (pm), or may vary between morning and afternoon allocation.

Class periods for core programmes are 4 hours long and are divided into 2 sessions with a break of 20 minutes between the sessions.

The morning and afternoon schedules and timings are shown in the tables below.

**Please note:** Morning classes start at 08.50 am sharp. Afternoon classes start at 1.30 pm sharp.

Non-core programmes, part-time courses, additional modules etc. are timetabled separately according to resource availability and the scheduling of core programmes. Classes for such additional modules may take place within regular daytime schedules & /or in the early evenings (6 pm- 8.30 pm) & / or on Saturdays.

## Programme & Class Location.

DCU Language Services is part of Dublin City University which operates across a number of \*campuses and satellite centres. All of the centres are located close to each other in the north of the city. Most DCU Language Services programmes and activities take place on the Glasnevin Campus. Customers should be aware that in peak periods programmes may take place in one or more of the other campuses or centres.

\*Glasnevin Campus, St Patrick's Campus, All Hallows Campus, Trinity Comprehensive School, St Aidan's School.

Classrooms are assigned to Language Services on a weekly basis by the University's centralized room allocation service. The service also allocates rooms to the university faculties and departments, undergraduate and post graduate programmes, conferences etc. This means that room allocation changes regularly in order to meet the diverse needs of the different university communities at various times. Like undergraduate and post-graduate university students, Language Services students may receive their tuition in more than one classroom.

## Junior Programmes

Junior programmes are scheduled individually according to course specifications. The schedules are arranged over specific days/periods within a 7-day timetable rota (Monday to Sunday) to meet course needs. Tuition days and class times are determined according to resource availability and in line with group arrival & departure dates and times.

## Public Holidays

DCU Language Services is closed:

- for all public holidays and bank holidays;
- on Good Friday;
- for a period of approximately 1-2 weeks over the Christmas and New Year period.
