Course Summary	This course is an introductory course for those who write the Entry Sheet first. We will explain what companies want to know through ES, preparations before writing, points when writing, how to configure, and Japanese expressions that are useful to know. Together in a small group lesson, let's write "What you work hard at when you were a student!" and "Self-introduction."	How do you express your research content and issues in Japanese when preparing materials for seminar presentations and research presentations? Also, when you're ready and giving a presentation in front of everyone, have you ever been in trouble because you don't know how to make a speech? Academic Japanese is not the only thing you need to present your research. Together, let's study more Japanese skills necessary for research. * Graduate students and undergraduate students aiming to enter graduate school are welcome.	Practice practical business conversations through role-playing tasks. The theme of each session is ① "participating in an internship" ② "working as a new employee" ③ "how to make a phone call in the business situations". In the latter half of each lesson, we will introduce examples related to the theme, so let's freely exchange opinions with each other.	While learning the flow and expressions of speech, we will hone your skills on how to convey in an easy-to-understand manner. We will also practice explaining basic illustrative materials (charts). On the last day, you are going to give a short presentation. Aim for a compelling speech. * Since the content is for N2 students, N1 holders may withdraw. * Those who can attend the whole three days with their web camera on during the sessions are encouraged to apply.	Do you usually use only "desu" or "masu" when talking? Can you talk correctly with your friends in a "casual" style? Let's practice pronunciation (accent and intonation) so that you can have a natural conversation. After that, practice conversation with other students through pair work.

Course Summary	While learning the expression and flow of speech, let's practice getting used to speaking efficiently Practice talking about a topic of your choice in one minute, and also collect the materials and introduce the countries and towns you want to visit. * Those who can attend the whole three days with their web camera on during the sessions are encouraged to apply.	Study useful expressions in daily life through role-playing. You will be able to explain how to cook, the condition and symptoms of your illness, and what you lost.	Practice the same type of question(Words·Vocabulary·Grammar) as seen in the actual JLPT exam(N1 level) through a series of patterns. This course aims to learn about exam trends, tips for solving problems and know your weaknesses.	Practice the same type of question as seen in the actual exam through a series of patterns. You can also learn how to study vocabulary as the basis of grammar, reading comprehension, and listening comprehension. This course is recommended to the people who are planning to start their studies for the N2 level of the JLPT exam in the future.
