## Alumni Today

歌手・声優・エッセイスト

Singer, voice actress, and essayist

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「なぜこう考えたんだろう」と 自分の内面と向き合う教えが 今に繋がっています。

1・2年生時に通った朝霞キャンパスの、緑豊かな大学らしい 雰囲気がとても好きだったことを覚えています。学食で友人たち と話したり、ゼミの仲間と卒業旅行に行ったり、学生生活を満喫 していました。この当時から声優や歌手の仕事に携わり、学業 との両立は大変でしたが、「どちらもやっているから中途半端だと は言われたくない」という想いもあり、その責任感を糧に頑張 れたのかもしれません。

印象に残っているのは、所属していたゼミの教員との出会い です。とてもユーモアがあり、私たち若者の意見に対しても柔軟 に耳を傾けてくださったのが印象的でした。「どうしてそう考え たの?」と質問されるのがゼミの進め方で、その答えには、良い 悪いといったことは言わず、ただ「なるほど」と……。今思い返 せば「なんで自分はそう考えたんだろう」と自問するきっかけを 作ってくれていたのだなと。当時、作詞の仕事をする上でも、 自分の内面と向き合う時間は大切で、何を伝えたい?何が好き? 何がわからない?と、普段意識していないことを具体的に深く 掘り下げる良いトレーニングになっていたと思います。

いま、私には挑戦したいことがたくさんあるのに時間が全然 足りないと感じています。でも大学時代は好きなことに没頭できる 時間がたくさんあります。また、大学生のあいだに失敗したことは 経験として糧にもなります。だからこそ、その時間を惜しみなく 使って、恥ずかしがらずさまざまな経験からたくさんのものを 吸収してほしいなと思います。

At university, I learned to listen to my inner voice, reflecting on the reasons for my thoughts. That attitude has made me who I am today.

I remember that I loved the atmosphere of the lush Asaka Campus, where I went during my first and second years. I think the atmosphere was unique to a university campus. I fully enjoyed my student life, chatting with friends at a cafeteria, and taking a graduation trip with fellow seminar members. I was already working as a voice actress and singer at that time, so it was very hard for me to study while working. However, I didn't like to be viewed as half-hearted on the basis of my studying and working at the same time. In hindsight, this sense of responsibility may have driven me to work hard.

My encounter with the instructor in charge of the seminar I belonged to left a strong impression on me. He had a good sense of humor, and I was deeply impressed by his flexible attitude toward listening to the views of young people like us. His seminars always proceeded with the same often-repeated question: "Why did you think so?" When we answered his question, he just said, "I see," instead of judging whether our answers were right or wrong... In hindsight, I now understand that he gave me a kind of cue to inwardly question myself. Since I use to write lyrics back then, spending time listening to my inner voice was very important for me. I believe that the practice of questioning myself as to what I wanted to express, what I liked, and what I didn't understand served as helpful training in digging deeply into what usually remained unconscious, in a concrete way.

I now feel that I don't have enough time to take up new challenges, though I have a long list of challenges I would like to accomplish. During your student years, you have a lot of time to devote yourself to doing what you like. Moreover, your student days are the phase of your life when all your failures turn into helpful experiences. That's why I hope that you as students do not hesitate to use your time to absorb many lessons from various experiences without feeling shy.
