- ►Students whose G.P.A. is 2.5/4.0 or higher 【Partner University】, 3.0/4.0 or higher 【ISEP/UMAP】.
- Students who have a Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) score of N3 or higher or the equivalent of CEFR B2 or higher in English or who come from a university where the language of instruction is Japanese or English.



Step 2: The guidelines for submitting documents through our web system, Toyo Net-ACE, will be sent to exchange program coordinators (students from partner universities and UMAP) or students (students from ISEP) after the deadline of the online application (around March 11). Please note that the online application is just one part of the application process. Students also need to submit other application documents through our web system. If you do not submit the documents by the deadline, we will take that to mean that you have declined the placement and withdrawn your application.

Students who have missing documents/errors will be asked to re-submit document(s). The deadline for resubmission will be announced after the documents have been screened.
