

**【Application Guideline】 Tuition Reduction Scholarship AY2026**

**1. 【The Main Purpose】**

The main purpose of the “Tuition Reduction Scholarship of Privately Financed International Students” is to reduce the financial burden of privately financed international students and to encourage their learning. Students receiving Tuition Reduction Scholarship are expected to study diligently and contribute globally after graduation while promoting interactions as a Toyo graduate and expanding their global networks.

**2. 【Reduction Rate】**

**3. 【Eligibility】**

1. The student is enrolled in the University with “Student” status as of May 1 for spring semester or as of October 31 for fall semester except for government scholarship students\*
2. The student has difficulty in pursuing his/her studies for financial reasons.
3. The monthly amount of financial support (excluding tuition) the student receives from his/her parents; siblings or relatives is 120,000 yen or less.
4. The student meets the academic performance criteria Table 1
5. The student has to be within the certain years required for completion of the course of study (Four years or eight semesters for undergraduates.) \*Absent period is not included.
6. The student has completed the survey of 「Tuition Reduction Scholarship」 on ToyoNet -ACE within the designated period.
7. The student has not received any disciplinary measures according to school regulations (cheating during exams, etc.).
8. The student is not recipient of Sports Incentive Scholarship.

\*If you have changed your status of residence to other than "Student" prior to the above base date and the change is approved, you will not be eligible for the scholarship.

1. For new students, eligibility is determined based on whether or not they have completed their subject registration. For students in the second year and beyond, eligibility is determined when they go to the next grade (GPA and number of credits requirement shown above).
2. For readmitted and returning students, eligibility is determined based on their academic results while in school, in accordance with the academic performance criteria above.
3. Those who transfer from a university other than Toyo University or those who transfer to another department will be treated as the first year only for the year.

<GPA calculation formula>

※GPA calculation considers only graduation requirements subjects of the previous academic year (2 semesters). Qualification subjects and free elective subjects are not included in the GPA calculation.

※"T" credits cannot be included in the GPA.

Regarding the cumulative number of credits earned in the academic performance standards, students who transfer or enroll in Toyo University from other universities should carefully check the standards for the number of credits required at the end of each academic year. If you do not register for a large number of courses after entering Toyo University, you may not be able to receive a tuition reduction or exemption for the following academic year or later. (Even if you take many courses, there may be cases where you do not fulfill the required credits.)

#### 4. 【Procedures and Refunds】

\*If you are unable to apply within the regular application acceptance period due to a change in your status of residence, you may be able to apply within the other application acceptance period. For more information, please contact the student support section at each campus.

<Notes>

- ① All privately financed international students will be automatically sorted into ToyoNet-ACE before application period depending on the timing of enrollment.
- ② “ **【Application Guideline】** Tuition Reduction Scholarship ” should be read carefully in advance and appropriate procedures should be taken within the designated period by the students on their own.
- ③ Eligibility and reduction rates will be determined by student’s application and academic results.

#### 6. **【Cancellation of the Scholarship】**

Students who are eligible for the Tuition Reduction Scholarship will not be eligible if any of the following apply to them. In addition, if a student becomes ineligible for the scholarship for some reason, he/she may be required to make an additional payment of the amount equivalent to the scholarship.

- (1) If the student no longer meets (1) through (8) of "3. **【Eligibility】** ".
- (2) If the student is expelled, suspended, or given a warning as stipulated in the Toyo University Academic Rules and Regulations
- (3) If the student is expelled or dismissed from the University.
- (4) If the student is otherwise deemed by the University to be inappropriate for exemption.

#### 7. **【Procedures for taking a leave of absence】**

If a person eligible for the Tuition Reduction Scholarship takes a leave of absence, the eligibility will be suspended during the leave period. If you complete the following procedures in the semester when you return to school and confirm that you meet the exemption qualifications again, you can regain your exemption qualifications.

- Procedure: Contact the Student Affairs Office (mlgaku-f@toyo.jp) to request resumption of the scholarship and complete the prescribed procedures.
- Deadline: April for students returning for the spring semester, and September for those returning for the fall semester.

#### 8. **【Report on study in Toyo by the recipient of Tuition Reduction Scholarship】**

Those who have received Tuition Reduction Scholarship even once should submit a report before graduation. You will be informed about the submission procedures a few months before your graduation.

**9. 【Precautions when studying abroad at an overseas university】**

If you are moving on to the next grade while studying abroad, you may not meet the academic criteria of "3. Eligibility (4)" because the credits taking at overseas university are not accredited at Toyo at the same time. In that case, you will not be able to receive Tuition Reduction Scholarship for the semester after returning to Japan. However, you may meet the academic criteria of "3. Eligibility (4)" retroactively as a result by the credits taken at overseas university are accredited after returning to Japan. If you had already applied Tuition Reduction Scholarship and couldn't meet the academic criteria of "3. Eligibility (4)" please submit the copy of Grade Report to the Student Support Section within two weeks after accrediting the credits. By completing these procedures, you may be able to receive a Tuition Reduction Scholarships by refund (or waiver if you have not paid the tuition fee) at a later date. Since it is not guaranteed that you will be eligible for these procedures, if you are planning to study abroad and are considering applying for the Tuition Reduction Scholarship for the semester after returning to Japan, please contact the Student Support Section in advance.
