# Toyo University Graduate Schools

## Entrance Examinations for the Internal Recommendation Category for April Admission 2026 (August Examination)

(Master's Program: Graduate Schools of Letters/Economics/Global and Regional Studies/International Tourism Management)

Toyo University Graduate Schools will hold the Entrance Examinations for the Internal Recommendation Category for April Admission 2026 in accordance with the following schedule.

●**Current students who were admitted in AY 2013 or later (Those whose GPA appears in the grade report)** are not required to submit an academic transcript for confirmation of grades, etc. Please refer to an up-to-date grade report downloading from ToyoNet-G and check whether you have met the application criteria below. The Application Guidelines are sent to the target students using Toyo University Official App, so please download them by yourself.

\*Students whose GPA does not appear on their grade report due to transferring university or the like are required to have their grades confirmed by the Education Affairs Section for Graduate Schools, so please check our official website below and submit the required documents by the due date. For students who have transferred from another university, calculation is made based on the credits earned after transferring Toyo University. They are also required to have earned 32 credits or more during their time in Toyo University's regular programs prior to the prescribed period for confirmation of grades, etc.

●**Current students in correspondence courses;** Since the GPA system has been applied to students admitted in AY 2014 or later, please read the following content by replacing the terms “students admitted in AY 2012 or earlier” and “students admitted in AY 2013 or later” with “students admitted in AY 2013 or earlier” and “students admitted in AY 2014 or later,” respectively.

\*1 Applicants who fail to satisfy the application criteria for the Internal Recommendation Category will be assigned to another entrance examination category even though they apply for the Internal Recommendation Category.

\*2 For each applicant, the average of his/her total academic results up to the time of grade confirmation for this application is checked against the application criteria. If you are in a full-year system, your academic records from the first year to the third year will be included for evaluation. If you are in a semester system, your academic records from the first semester to the previous semester (academic records up to the sixth semester for students expected to graduate in March 2026, and up to the seventh semester for students expected to graduate in September 2025) will be included for evaluation. For students enrolled in correspondence courses, however, their academic results at the time of grade confirmation for this application will be evaluated.

\*3 Students in the fourth year of target faculties/departments mean those expected to graduate in September 2025 or March 2026. (Students who are allowed to graduate from the undergraduate program after their third year in the Faculty of Economics mean those in the third year and expected to graduate in September 2025 or March 2026.) If you are enrolled in a faculty/department whose name has been changed, please contact the Education Affairs Section for Graduate Schools in advance to confirm whether it is possible for you to take the Entrance Examinations for the Internal Recommendation Category.

Students whose GPA does not appear on their grade report due to transferring university or the like are required to calculate it by themselves by using the formula below. Please confirm whether or not the GPA meets the requirement above and submit a grade report issued on April 1 or later during the prescribed period for confirmation of grades, etc.

\*When you calculate the GPA, be sure to include the subjects whose credits are required for graduation and not to include certification courses and other subjects that are not regarded as credits required for graduation. For re-taken courses, please use the updated grades only and do not include the grade that you took first in the calculation. Please round down to the second decimal place.
