

- ① Deforestation means that people cut down trees and clear large areas of forests. This is happening all around the world, and it's a big problem for the environment. Forests are important for many reasons. They are home to many animals and plants, keep the air clean, and play a big role in controlling the Earth's climate. When we destroy forests, it causes many serious problems for the planet.
- 2 There are several reasons why people cut down trees and clear forests. One of the main reasons is to create more land for farming. As the world's population grows, people need more food, so they clear forests to grow crops or raise animals. Another reason is the need for wood. Trees are cut down to make paper, furniture, and other products that we use every day. In some places, forests are cleared to build new cities, roads, or factories. Sometimes, people clear forests to ① mine precious things.
- 3 Deforestation has many bad effects on the environment. One of the most important effects is the loss of habitat for animals and plants. Forests are home to many different species. When forests are destroyed, these animals and plants lose their homes. Some species may even become endangered or extinct. This loss of biodiversity can harm the balance of nature and make it harder for ecosystems to work properly. Another major problem caused by deforestation is land loss.

 2 Trees help to keep the soil in place with their roots. When trees are cut down, the soil can easily be washed away by rain. This makes the land less rich. That means it is harder to grow crops. Land loss can also cause rivers and lakes to fill with dirt and can lead to water pollution and harm fish and other water life.
- 4 A deforestation is related to climate change. Trees 3 absorb CO₂, a gas that causes the Earth to warm up. When trees are cut down and burnt, CO₂ they have stored is released back into the air. This increases the amount of CO₂ in the atmosphere, leading to global warming. Global warming can cause many problems. They include more extreme weather events like storms and floods.
- 5 Forests are sometimes called the "lungs of the Earth" because they produce oxygen and absorb carbon dioxide. Forests play an important role in the water cycle by absorbing rain and releasing water back into the air. This can 4 prevent floods and keeps rivers and lakes full of clean water. Forests are also important for the people who live in them. Many local people depend on forests for their food, medicine, and shelter. These communities have lived in harmony with the forests for thousands of years. When forests are destroyed, these people lose their homes and their way of life is threatened.
- 6 There are many things we can do to stop deforestation. One important way is to plant more trees. Planting trees where forests have been cut down, known as reforestation, can help to restore the environment. It can also create new homes for animals and plants. Another way to stop deforestation is to use less paper and wood. Recycling paper and using products made from recycled materials can reduce the need to cut down more trees.

- 7 We can also support 5 <u>sustainable forestry practices</u>. This means cutting down trees in a way that allows the forest to grow back naturally. Companies that practice sustainable forestry make sure that for every tree they cut down, they plant a new one. By buying products from these companies, we can support the practice.
- 8 In conclusion, deforestation is a serious problem that affects everyone on the planet. By understanding the causes and effects of deforestation, and by taking action to stop it, we can protect our forests and make sure they continue to provide for future generations.
